**The body of Abstract as follows;**

**Objectives:** All abstracts have to be written strictly according to the instructions set here. **Methods:** The title should be typed in all capital letters. The authors' name should be written as the initials followed by putting periods. Last Name should be written in full spelling. Please tick off presenting author when you type the author information online. The presenting author will be underlined in the abstract book. **Results:** When typing body of the abstract, do not make spaces (Enter key presses) between paragraphs. Special characters must be inserted into the document using the SPECIAL CHARACTER function. Do not exceed 250 words in the body of abstract. If your abstract contains any tables, please reduce 8~10 words in the body per line. i.g.) If the table is five lines, 50 words should be reduced. **Conclusions:** Ensure that your abstract is grammatically correct and free of typographical errors.
